These stars know that no outfit is complete without impeccable hair and makeup. Here's the inside scoop



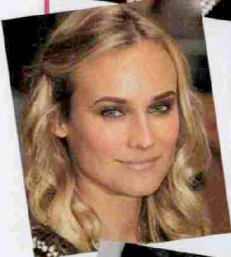
Reese Witherspoon

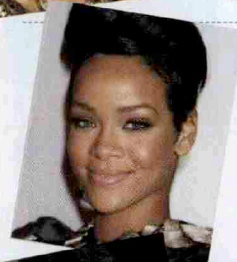
Michelle Obama
